

## 5830 PUPIL FUND RAISING

The Board of Education does not permit the solicitation of funds by and from the pupils of this district during the school day in order to protect pupils from unnecessary pressures and the instructional program from disruption. However, the PTA and/or district staff may conduct fundraisers. Any fundraising on school property must be approved by the Superintendent/Principal.

Pupils may solicit and collect money on behalf of non-school organizations, provided the fundraising has been approved by the Superintendent/Principal.

Out-of-school solicitation of money for non-school organizations must be approved by the Superintendent/Principal.

No pupil will be permitted to solicit and collect money on school premises or at a school-sponsored event for the pupil's own benefit, with the exception of the after-school TREPS program. All TREPS fundraising must be at the afterschool TREPS public marketplace, supervised by the pupil's parents, and approved by the Superintendent/Principal. The pupil's parents are responsible for accounting for and reporting all financial gains associated with the fundraising.

No person or organization may solicit funds on school property without the express permission from the building Superintendent/Principal.

The Board of Education does not permit fundraising activities involving unsupervised solicitation.

The Board shall not be responsible for the protection of or the account of funds collected from pupils by organizations outside the schools, by teaching staff members when not required to collect money for a Board approved purpose, and by school connected organizations.

The Superintendent/Principal shall approve the times and places in which pupil fundraising may be conducted and ensure that appropriate adults are responsible for adequate accounting of funds collected.
